

Authorizing Studio Vision (Challenge-Response)

While it is still possible to authorize Studio Vision Pro using the provided master floppy disk, it is also possible to authorize Studio Vision Pro on a Macintosh computer that does not have a floppy drive.

When first launching Studio Vision Pro you will be prompted to authorize the program. You can authorize by either inserting your key disk, or by entering a **Challenge Response** Code. A 30-day registration period is provided where you can use the program without it being authorized. Once this grace period ends, however, the program will no longer launch until the authorization is performed.

IMPORTANT: For those who do not have Web and email access, you will need to contact Opcode's Customer Service department (at 650/429-2400) to receive a Challenge Response Code.

NOTE: While it is preferred that international users get their Challenge Response Codes from their particular distributor (see the International Distributor list included in your Opcode package), they too can use the online method discussed below.

You Must Be Registered

Before Opcode can issue you a Response Code, you must be a registered user. If you haven't yet, please complete and return the registration card included in your software package. Don't worry though, you can still use your software for up to 30 days without performing the authorization. This is plenty of time for you to get registered and have a Response Code issued to you.

Install Your Software

To use Studio Vision Pro on your floppyless Mac, you will first need to install the program. We recommend using the Easy Install option as it will install all the files needed to run Studio Vision Pro.

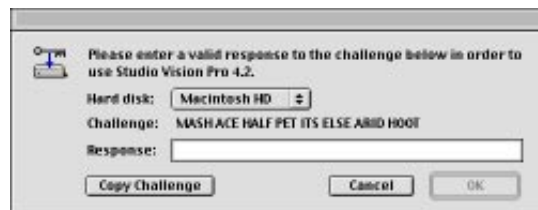
Send Us Your Challenge Code

Before Opcode can issue you a Response Code, you must first send us your Challenge Code:

- ① **Launch your Opcode application and click the Authorize button when prompted.**
- ② **When asked to insert your Key Disk click the Cancel button.**
- ③ **In the next dialog, make note of the Challenge Code (either write it down or click the Copy button)**

Then click the Cancel button.

- ④ **Go to the Opcode Web site (www.opcode.com) and then the "Support" page.**
- ⑤ **Follow the link to the "Challenge Response" page and read the instructions.**

Enter the requested personal information and type (or paste) in your Challenge Code in the provided field.

- ⑥ **When done, click the Submit button.**

Authorize with Your Response Code

Once Opcode has received your Challenge Code and verified your registration information, a Response Code will be emailed to you. To authorize your Opcode application with your Response Code:

- ① **Launch your Opcode application and click the Authorize button when prompted.**
- ② **When asked to insert your Key Disk click the Cancel button.**
- ③ **In the following dialog, type in your Response Code in the provided field. Make sure to type in the necessary spaces between each word.**



You can also paste in the code from your email.

- ④ **From the "Hard disk" pop-up choose your System hard disk, then click the OK button.**

Once your Opcode software is authorized, it will run from any hard disk connected to your computer—as long as the originally specified System disk remains available. Moving the program to a different computer requires a new Response Code. For additional Response Codes, contact Opcode's Customer Service department (at 650/429-2400).
