

Removing Software

Q: "How do I remove my old software?"

Removing, Vision/StudioVision, Galaxy/GPE and OMS from your computer. Drag the following to the trash:

- I. Vision/Studio Vision- 2 files, 1. The application folder on your hard disk. 2. The Vision/Studio Vision preferences in the preferences folder of the system folder.
- II. Galaxy/GPE 4 files, 1. The application folder on your hard drive, 2. The Galaxy Librarians folder in the system folder. 3. The Galaxy Setups folder in the System folder. 4. The Glaxy Keyword document in the preferences folder in the system folder.
- III. OMS 3 files, 1. The OMS application on your hard disk. 2. The OMS folder in the system folder. 3. The Open Music System (Opcode Midi System on older versions of OMS) extension in the extensions folder of the system folder.

Once these files (Total of 9: 3 application folders, 3 in the system folder, 2 in the preferences and 1 in the extensions folder.) have been put in the trash, and the trash has been emptied, you have completely removed these programs from your computer and you may reinstall, or install an upgrade of the software.
