



Vision for Windows 1.4.6 and Windows 95

Q: The pencil disappears in the graphical editing window in Vision 1.4.6 and Windows 95.

A: This is a known problem with Vision for Windows and Windows 95. What is happening is the system resources are being eaten up every time you make an edit in the graphic editing window and probably elsewhere. We wrote Vision for Windows long before there was Windows 95 so its no wonder that it doesn't work with the new memory management. Vision is a very memory intensive application, that's why it has such great timing and midi features.

We are about to release Vision for Windows 2.5 that is Windows 95 compatible and has the new look, comes with Galaxy and OMS 2.0, and also includes nice features like notation editing and printing, name manager support, a nice graphical track overview, and best of all you probably get a free upgrade to it. ;-)

So in the mean time you can make a few edits, save and reboot Windows.
